## What is Ballet Intensive all about?

Ballet Intensive programs are held all around the world every Summer varying in duration from 2 to 6 weeks depending on a dancer's level and maturity. **At Arizona Dance Artistry we have held a Ballet Intensive every Summer to give our SERIOUS students a chance to focus on their ballet training much like they do their school work.** In a concentrated 2 week program, our students get **48 hours of ballet and other technique training**, expediting their class training. Summer program is when our students are invited to begin their Pointe Prep training as well as begin Pointe based on Placement class. **Our younger dancers participate in a 1 week, 25-hour program** that may be taken in June, July or both, totaling 50 hours of ballet training when combined.

During the Ballet Intensive, dancers gain education in dance history, ballet vocabulary, sewing tips for ballet shoes and have been exposed to guest choreographers and teachers. This goes hand in hand with their daily Ballet, Pointe (for Pointe levels only), Modern, Jazz Progressions, Pilates and Choreography class to build a well-rounded and educated dancer. **Ballet Intensive program will also earn our older dancers points towards National Honor Society of Dance Arts.** Each year the Ballet faculty at AZDA is amazed at how much our students grow in this outstanding Summer opportunity. Each intensive concludes with a casual in-studio showcase of our class work that all family and friends are invited to attend.
